### Announcing an enhancement to our Out-of-Canada benefit maximum for new SunAdvantage plans

Effective December 1, 2010, the Out-of-Canada lifetime benefit maximum for Emergency Services under our standard Extended Health Care (EHC) plans is increasing to \$3 million for new SunAdvantage plans.

#### What's changing?

Currently, the Out-of-Canada lifetime benefit maximum for Emergency Services under our standard SunAdvantage EHC benefit is \$1 million. On December 1, 2010, we are increasing this benefit maximum to \$3 million to provide your clients and their members with enhanced coverage at no additional cost. This product enhancement will apply to all SunAdvantage quotes and sales covering active members, as of December 1, 2010.

#### What's not affected by this change?

This enhancement doesn't apply to:

- any covered members of EHC plans who have retiree coverage,
- the Out-of-province/Canada Referral Services benefit offered under our EHC plans,
- any of your clients who currently have a SunAdvantage EHC plan.

#### What does this mean for you?

Starting December 1, 2010 you will notice the enhancement in the proposals we prepare for you. As well, any new sales as of December 1 will automatically include the new \$3,000,000 lifetime maximum.
